

## WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN VISITING VARIOUS RINKS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC (version 1.2)

**Masks must be worn at all times at all facilities, except when on ice.**

Feildian Gardens	Parents are required to sign in at front entrance for all IHL games.	2 family members per player. Maximum 100 people in attendance.	Groups are permitted entry 15 minutes prior to their session. Groups have 15 minutes to exit the facility after their session.  Spectator Policy: "We encourage two per household; however, AMHA is a family friendly association and we recognize there may be circumstances where more than 2 per player can be acceptable. We must adhere to the maximum of 100 spectators per session. Spectators are reminded that they must leave the rink immediately after each session."
Bell Island	Parents and Players are required to fill out the Covid 19 Self Assessment form prior to all IHL scheduled games. The form is posted on the BIMHA Website.	Maximum 100 people in attendance.	Parents are not permitted in dressing rooms. Please arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to scheduled time. The facility must be cleared within 15 minutes after the conclusion of the game.
Glacier	For IHL games, parents and players Parents/spectators will be required to sign in at the entrance.  Players will be covered through the game sheet.	Limited to 2 parents/spectators per player. Maximum of 100 people in attendance (includes players, coaches, officials, staff).  Note: doors to facility will lock shortly after the game starts.	Groups are permitted entry to the facility 10 minutes prior to their session. Doors will be locked until then. Groups have 10 minutes to exit the facility after their session. Parents/spectators should exit the building at the conclusion of the game and pick-up players outside.  Parents are not permitted in the dressing rooms. Dressing rooms have capacity restraints (9 in G2, 12 in G1).  No food or drink is permitted in the building.
Goulds Arena	Parents are required to sign-in at the front entrance for all IHL games for tracing purposes.	Two parents/spectators per player. Maximum 100 people in attendance (includes players, coaches, officials, and staff).	Players can enter facility maximum 15 minutes prior to session and exit within 15 minutes of session ending.
Southern Shore Arena	Parents are required to sign-in at front entrance of the arena for tracing purposes.	140-person total, which includes, players, coaches, arena staff and on ice officials are permitted in the building. Once 140 people are in building, nobody else will be permitted inside.	Signage will be posted on the front door advising what entrance to be used. Signage will also be posted on dressing room doors stating maximum number of people allowed in at any one time. Once inside building, spectators must move to assigned bleacher area. No spectators can loiter around the front of building or entrance once kids are on the ice. Players and spectators can enter building 10 minutes prior to start of their session and must vacate building within 10 minutes of session ending.  <b><u>There is absolutely NO Parking at the rear of the building.</u></b>

**Please note that the above table is only be a quick synopsis of the protocols at various rinks and not a comprehensive document. Concerned parties should contact rinks and Home Associations directly if official detailed protocol documents and policies are desired. IHL does not have the authority to impose any uniform COVID-19 protocol standards across the facilities we utilize.**
