### COVID-19 Facility Guidelines

Revised Nov. 16, 2020






The following outlines a revision to the Ken Williams Southern Shore Arena COVID-19 Facility Guidelines to facilitate 15 minute cleaning breaks between sessions as approved by Gov NL, effective Nov. 16, 2020:

- The main aspect of the revised guidelines is the segregation of the facility into 2 separate areas.
- The facility drawing attached illustrates how the arena will be segregated with separate entrances/exits for each area.
- The first session of the day would have Group 1 enter the facility partially dressed in the hockey equipment 15 minutes before their session time and proceed to the assigned dressing rooms in the Group 1 Area to put on skates and helmet.
- Separate multiple dressing rooms will be used in each area to ensure physical distancing is maintained. Once Group 1 session is over and the players are back in the dressing rooms, the entrance/exit door in Area 2 will be opened and Group 2 will proceed to the assigned dressing rooms in Area 2.
- Group 1 will quickly remove skates and helmets and exit the building within 10 minutes and before Group 2 exits the dressing rooms and proceeds to the ice for the next session. While one group is on the ice, the dressing rooms and contact surfaces in the other area will be sanitized prior to the next group entering the facility.
- This process will be repeated throughout the day.
- This plan will prevent any cross-contact of the incoming and outgoing groups within the 15 minute break between sessions.
